In order to qualify for the Scholarship, you must submit a paper describing your involvement in, and service to, the running community, as well as your personal running accomplishments.

Please keep in mind that we are not necessarily interested in the star of the high school track or cross-country team. Rather, for example, we want to recognize the student who helped raise funds to send the team to an out-of-town meet or who helped organize a road race or track meet to help out a local charity. *The key is that this is a SERVICE-oriented scholarship rather than one based on athletic accomplishments.*

* Submitted papers are to be a maximum of three pages in length, typed and double-spaced.

* Please also provide the names and contact information of two references (no relatives please).
